Hitec X4AC Pro Multicharger (4-port AC/DC charger). Works fine for 3 and 4 cell Lipos, but the charge capability (wattage) is lacking for charging 6 cell batteries (especially big batteries) efficiently. Comes with EC3, EC5, XT60, "servo" connectors for charging RX batteries, & JST charge cables + 4 balance boards and instruction manual. Also comes with toolbox for transport. Asking \$60. Training setup. Tundra airplane (no floats, but has float landing gear wires). No flap servos (flaps are taped in place). No cowling as the plane was in a crash, but has been repaired and has flown since. Main Tx is a Futaba 10CAP (FASST) and the buddy box is a Futaba 7C without the TX function; trainer cord is included. Both transmitters have 3S LiFE batteries installed. Comes with 2 Lipo 3s 2200mah batteries with XT60 connectors (for the plane). Also included is a Dualsky FC151 6-axis flight control that is installed in the airplane.
